

6th - 8th Grades Summer Reading Project: Book Presentation

6th-8th grades projects are due **the first Friday of the school year**. Students will not have time for completion during the school hours. Students must take and pass an A.R. quiz on all **THREE** books for a grade.

Instructions:

1. Choose three chapters books from the provided list.
2. You will only choose **ONE** book to present your project.
3. Your project will consist of a summary of the story.
 - Use details from the story to include in your summary
 - Your summary should be longer than a paragraph.
 - Check for spelling, sentence structure, capitalization, and punctuation when writing your summary.
4. The following five questions should be answered:
 - What is the main idea and details of the story?
 - What is the author's point of view?
 - How does the plot help shape the story?
 - Character Development: Who are the main characters?
What are the personality traits of the characters listed in the story?
 - What was the most interesting thing you learned from the story?
5. You will create a visual on a mini poster board for the book you have chosen to present.
 - This will include different pictures of things related to the story.
 - You may include footnotes next to your pictures to explain what the pictures are.
 - Be creative!
