WELCOME TO THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR! – We are one Body!

I first want to thank you for all your support and your love last school year; you made my first year at Holy Family a wonderful experience which motivates me to renew my commitment to provide quality education to our children. We have been working very hard to welcome our students in a clean, safe, and pleasant learning environment. As we are preparing for the new school year, please be aware of the information below:

IMMUNIZATION RECORDS:

Schools begin on August 17, 2022; your child must have a current immunization Health Department Form 684 (blue and yellow forms) completed and submitted to the office; otherwise, your child cannot attend school after August 26, 2022.

*All students entering Kindergarten must have had two (2) varicella vaccinations before the first day of school.

*All students entering 7th grade must have had one TDAP vaccination and one meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination before the first day of school.

Remember that FREE vaccines are available at the Health Department. Call (786)845-0550 to schedule an appointment.

SCHOOL SCHEDULE:

Students will report directly to their homeroom classes on August 17, 2022. School hours are Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Details will follow on the weekly school bulletin and the school calendar for early dismissal days, holidays, and other vacation days. All meals (breakfast, lunch, and snack) are free for all children; breakfast is served from 7:15 a.m. to 7:40 a.m. every day.

AFTER-SCHOOL CARE:

After care begins 15 minutes after school dismissal until 5:45 p.m. Any child not picked up by 3:15 p.m. will be placed in aftercare, and parents are responsible to pay the fee. For the 2022-2023 school year, parents who know that they will use the aftercare program are encouraged to enroll their child by filling out the aftercare form and pay the registration fee.

COVID-19 UPDATES

The school is taking all necessary measures to adhere to the CDC guidelines in order to contribute to the eradication of the pandemic. Correspondence will be sent to you in reference to the COVID-19 protocols at a later date.
